St. Clair County Health Department's Drive-thru COVID Vaccine site at 330 West Main Street, Belleville and IDPH's Community-Based COVID Testing Site at St. Clair Square will cease operations on March 31, 2022

Belleville, IL – March 30, 2022 – St. Clair County Health Department's drive-thru COVID vaccine clinic at 330 West Main Street last day of operation will be Thursday, March 31, 2022. Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson COVID vaccines are still available per CDC guidelines for age 12 and up today until 6 p.m. and Thursday, March 31, 2022 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.. No appointment necessary.

Starting Friday, April 1, 2022, clients may receive their COVID vaccines at the St. Clair County Health Department located at 19 Public Square, Belleville, Illinois, Monday thru Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. (last appointment will be 3:30 pm). Appointments are REQUIRED and can be set through the health departments website: <https://www.co.st-clair.il.us/Departments/Health-Department/COVID-19-Information/Vaccination-Screen>. This is NOT a drive-thru location. Clients are asked to enter the ticketed parking lot in first block of West A Street, take a parking ticket upon entry, enter at the center door of the building and check in at the clinic window. Clients will be given a free parking pass to exit.

A Mask and a Photo ID are required. Clients are asked to bring their vaccination card and will be required to wait 15 to 30 minutes after receiving their COVID vaccination in order to assess for potential reactions. To cancel an appointment or for more information call 618-825-4447 Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) released a statement late last week in response to the sharp drop in the demand for COVID-19 testing services at the ten [Community-Based Testing Sites](#) and the anticipated end of federal funding, operations at these locations will end on March 31, 2022. This includes the Community-Based Testing Site at St. Clair Square. The last day to receive a COVID test at St. Clair Square is Thursday, March 31st from 8 am to 4 pm.
